WHICH ASSESSMENTS DO WE OFFER?

Full Autism Assessment

Location AEIOU Assessment Clinic



What:

Our Full Autism Assessment provides a detailed evaluation of autism symptoms and behaviours across areas of development often affected by autism, and observed within different environments (i.e., home and kindergarten/school).

Assessment Package Includes

An overview of developmental history and concerns, as well as assessment and detailed clinical reports of:

- Language and communication
- Daily living skills and adaptive behaviours
- Socialisation skills and difficulties
- Sensory processing and aversions
- Early learning skills (children under age 69 months)
- Repetitive/restricted behaviours associated with autism
- ADOS-2 Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (Clinical observations of autism behaviours)

Note. We do not provide cognitive or intelligence testing (i.e., WISC, WPPSI).

What:

The Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule (ADOS-2) is a semi-structured clinical assessment that identifies characteristics and behaviours related to autism in children through observation and structured activities.

This assessment package typically includes:

- ADOS-2 Assessment
- A clinical report with a full, in-depth overview of assessment observations, responses and ADOS-2 scores
- Report of brief developmental history and current challenges/concerns

Who: Children aged 3 – 8 years Cost: \$600
