START YOUR EARLY INTERVENTION JOURNEY AT AN AEIOU OPEN DAY

At AEIOU Foundation, we recognise the first step is often the hardest, which is why we tailor our Open Day events to demonstrate the support and guidance families will become accustomed to throughout their time with us.

Our September events, held across all centres from 25th – 28th, not only offer parents important information about how they can access the best support for their child with autism, but will also give a snapshot into a typical day of early intervention therapy.

The morning will include a tour, meet and greet with centre educators and therapists and an overview of how we develop key communication, behaviour, social and independence skills. There will also be a short workshop on *Understanding Challenging Behaviours*. But above all, it is an opportunity to ask questions and seek advice on the all-important 'next steps'.
