Parents and carers have access to workshops and resources; while the long day-care model enables them to continue working and contributing economically to their family unit, and the broader community.

AS an NDIS Provider, eligible children will be able to secure reasonable and necessary supports to access our program. The program will be delivered by:

- Behaviour Therapists
- Occupational Therapists
- Speech Pathologists
- Early childhood teachers
- Skilled learning facilitators

AEIOU Logan will feature purpose designed classrooms, parents' retreat and training facilities, large covered outdoor play facilities and research facilities.
